Remarks

APPLICATION DETAILS

Surface Preparation

Blast cleaning the steel structure to remove all traces of rust, dirt, oil and grease.

Application Procedure

MIXING

Open can "A" and mix thoroughly to achieve a homogeneous and unified color. Once the first step is completed add component "B" which is the hardener and mix also at a low speed (upwards and downwards) for 2-3 minutes to achieve also a homogeneous finish.

Application Method

Depending on the color shade of the Steel structure, a side trial application should be conducted in order to estimate the exact quantity to be used at the exact dry film thickness needed, following the approved variation of thickness required in One to Two coats of application.

METHOD OF MIXING:

- 1. Pour Part B into Part A
- For large volume mixing use a low speed drill and mix it for 1 min
- 3. Thinner: Max 5% using **thinner ZP**

THEORETICAL SPREADING RATE

10m² / ltr @ 100 microns Wet Film Thickness

Min / Max: 100 - 200 microns WFT

TOPCOATS

Depending on the substrate and area of application, **BAYCOR ZP** can be over coated with the following top coats:

- For steel Structure: Epoxy based BAYCOAT 125
- For concrete structure: BAYCOAT 500
- For Exposed Steel and concrete structure: Polyurethane based CONCOAT PU 70

CURING

2-6 hrs Touch Dry

1-2 days full dry depending on weather conditions 5 days Full cure
